Cost of Attendance

Cost of Attendance (known hereafter as COA) is an estimated average of the amount of money students will spend on education related expenses over the length of their program. COA is split into two categories which are Direct and Indirect Costs. Direct costs are comprised of what the school will actually charge you to attend. Indirect costs are comprised of what students typically spend on their own personal living expenses. These indirect costs are calculated by surveying the student body and averaging the responses. The school <u>WILL NOT</u> charge you for any of these indirect costs. Your personal investment in your education will be determined by your Direct Costs.
